The BVRR's Wilder Branch runs from Wilder to Caldwell, Idaho and the Boise Cut Off runs from Nampa to just southeast of Boise, Idaho. The BVRR has also obtained trackage rights from Nampa to Caldwell, Idaho from the Union Pacific Railroad.

Corporation announced a definitive agreement for Berkshire Hathaway to acquire for \$100

per share in cash and stock the remaining 77.4 percent of outstanding BNI shares not


"World's Great Hobby on Tour" Show
