## Prototype Signaling & Whistles 1900-2008

Bill Harper and Dan Gould will present a superb clinic concerning everything you ever wanted to know about railroad signaling and whistling. They will begin by discussing the historical timeline of rail signaling. Included will be descriptions of the generic track signals used in Great Britain, NORAC, Santa Fe and Union Pacific covering aspect, indication, and meaning

in color. A few wayside signs will be included. This will introduce rules 251 and 261. Discussion will continue on to Prototype blocks, treadles, and detection systems and how the model industry applies these. Using a

19th century Northern Pacific rule book from the



web, they will introduce the flagging system and whistle signal systems (they will provide hand outs for the whistle lists). Finally, Bill and Dan have agreed to try to answer any questions you might have on the topic!





Meanwhile, in Coupeville, Rich Thom is busy with benchwork and wiring on his HO scale Coldwater Creek & Cascade logging railroad.






On Fidalgo, John White has been very busy adding on to the existing (shown above at the Wassail in December), with a new 40 foot section and a new DCC control/dispatching area.
