- Wanting to run those cool trains of yours on a larger layout?

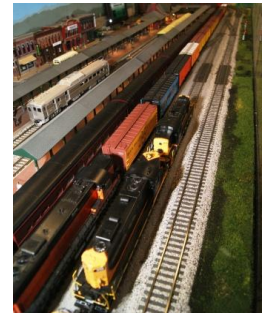
