S DIVISION REPORT

Inspired by the industrial switching layout being added to the HO scale layout, I set this up at home on some drawers and conveniently sized plywood. After some thought, and some paint, I installed a switching layout near the S Scale (American Flyer) layout at the club house. It is under some displays of historic signs and pictures.

I decided to make it a touch and play exhibit, so the kids who hear "don't touch" would be able to create some memories of what happens in a real train yard. The main line locomotive has no armature, so is free wheelingthus the steam chests still look like they are working. The Baldwin switch engine is a shell on a box car frame. The switches are all manual (unfortunately they reflect the history of changing design). There are 2 manual uncouplers to add to the play realism.

With the advise I've received, I've started to create switching scenarios using pictures on playing cards. So far I have two: put together a train in the order of the card deck, and shuffle the cars in a train to various sidings.

There are two locomotive shells: one is prewar and is metal, the other is post war and is baklite.
