
Tool Time:



Main Event Mark Malmkar on Airbrushing

Mark Malmkar, MMR, was our featured speaker and tonight Mark talked about airbrushing, covering the basics from the types of airbrushes to air sources to spray booths. He then delved into the types of paints commonly airbrushed: acrylic and solvent based (enamels, lacquers). Also included was a breakdown on the different types of thinners to be used (most paint to be airbrushed needs to be thinned appropriately), and Mark also discussed primers and the need to apply a primer coat to establish a common base for your airbrush application.

After Mark's presentation, the group adjourned to outside, where Mark gave a live demo of his airbrushing techniques.
