Operating Steam Locomotives on the Computer in Train Simulator Classic

For the November clinic we will experience the world of virtual railroading using Train Simulator Classic – a game by Dovetail Games that is a modern evolution of the original Microsoft Train Simulator. Not only is the simulator highly entertaining and realistic, it is also very educational showcasing many prototypical features in operating locomotives that are very difficult if not impossible to emulate in model railroading. In this session, Rich will showcase steam locomotive operations featuring historic locomotives of the Union Pacific. We will see and run the early 1868 4-4-0 steamer UP No. 119 to the humongous million-pound Big Boy articulated. We will jump in the cabs and see what it takes to control and fire these machines up and maybe learn a few things along the way.
